- Mr. Cichanowski will do a rough re-format and get the existing draft document out to all within
 a week. The ZA will print copies and notify commission members when they are ready for pickup. We will send a copy to Michael Batcher at BCRC to help him prepare for a visit from Mr.
 Foley.
- We will need to secure new photos of solar installations, the garage, Howard Park, farms, what else?
